## Goal: March 15th

## What Does it Take to Bring Grade 3 All-In?

- Approx. 24 (out of 133) students would move out of current rooms
- Create two new classrooms (12/12)
- Hire two new teachers for those 24 students

In order for this to happen.... adjustments needed to be made to four classrooms

- Move a class to Art room and computer lab (saves both classes)
- Multiple classrooms would expand to additional adjoining rooms (save both classes)
- If the classes did not get creative with space, we would move 53 students and need 3 or 4 new classrooms


## What Does it Take to Bring Grade 4 All-In?

- Originally, approx. 40 students would move out of current rooms
- Create three new classrooms (13/13/14)
- Hire three new teachers for those 40 students

But...In order to get it to TWO new classrooms...

- We can move a class to larger space (library) and acquire an adjoining classroom
- 28 students for two classrooms is the goal ( $14 / 14$ )
- 28 out of 110 hybrid students


## What Does it Take to Bring Grade 5 All-In?

- Originally approx. 35 students would move out of current rooms
- Create two/three new classrooms
- Hire two or three new teachers for those 35 students

But....In order to get it to TWO new classrooms

- Move a class to an adjoining classroom
- 30 students for two classrooms is the goal $(15 / 15)$
- 30 out of 115 hybrid students


## The Transition

- Plan for informing parents and students
- Teacher collaboration
- Using a day to prepare
- Moving of furniture and materials
- Ordering additional teacher Math/ELA supplies
- Bus transportation


## SUMMARY- ALL GRADES IN

- March 15th
- Need funding for 6 New Teachers and 3 Education Assistants/Materials
- Approx 80 students being moved out of current classrooms (out of 360 hybrid)
- Art Room, Library, Computer Lab become classrooms
- Some Teachers use two rooms to keep entire class
- No hybrid

Other Considerations:

- Increase of traffic due to more cars
- Lengthen afternoon pick-up


## If Gr 3 Comes in....Can we add "struggling students?"

- Approx 50 seats available in Gr 4 and 5
- Hybrid will still exist in Gr 4 and 5
- Hybrid would be gone for Gr 3
- $50 \%$ of all hybrid students in Gr 3-5 would be "4 Days-In"
